## Ask the Watercolor Doctor: by Carol Z. Brody NWS

Question:

Even though I belong to the Palm Beach Watercolor Society, I don't think of myself as an artist. I'm not much of a self starter and just seem to follow along with the crowd. Is it important for me to have a goal regarding my art?

Answer:

There are many different perspectives that we each have about our art and what it represents to us. For some of us, painting in a weekly class is enough to satisfy us. We are looking for something to occupy a slot of time, and we enjoy the companionship we find in the class. We never paint at home. If our painting turns out well, it's a bonus, though we rarely show it to anyone, let alone exhibit it anywhere. For others of us, having a finished painting to exhibit in one or two local shows a year is nice, but we don't really see ourselves as being serious about our work. We don't have any particular goals for ourselves. We take an occasional workshop if our friends are going, and sometimes we do see some improvement in our paintings, but just don't believe we'll ever really be accomplished in our work. We have a space at home where we occasionally paint, but it isn't worth the bother of claiming it as our studio.

Still others of us are quite serious about our efforts, and we take workshops or classes with the intent of truly bringing our paintings to a higher level. Many of us have dedicated spaces to paint in, where we can leave our materials out and ready to use. Sometimes we are even rewarded by winning awards and gaining acceptances into juried exhibitions. We show our work as widely as we can, even setting up one or two person shows, and we think of ourselves as "artists", that scary word for some of us! When we read Watercolor Artist Magazine, we dream of seeing our work published there. We wonder if we could ever become "known" for our work or style, or if we could be the ones teaching the classes or workshops. Do we have goals? You bet we do!

I truly believe that in the long run you won't accomplish much if you don't reach for it and make it happen. This involves choices and allocating time and space for doing that. But it also comes down to your vision of where you want to be in the future, and what your mindset is in relation to your art. The path isn't always direct, and the trajectory isn't always straight upward, but if you desire it, only you can bring it about. Now, have I inspired you? I certainly hope so!

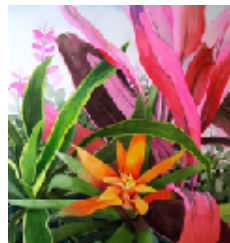
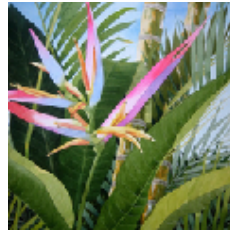
