### Ask the Watercolor Doctor:

I was recently asked what I thought about “artist envy.” What is it? Why does it exist? Is it a destructive force or can it play a positive role in one’s life?

#### Answer:

I think that artist envy could just as likely be tennis envy or dance envy or beauty envy etc., but I will try to focus my answer on artists in this column. When we see the work of another artist in a class or at a show, we generally make a mental judgment about whether or not we like the piece and whether we think it has merit. We probably also ask ourselves how our own work holds up in comparison, and this is the crux of the matter.

When we hear that someone else has won an award, we want to be happy for them and support them. However, it’s natural to wish we had achieved recognition too, and we feel envious. But this artist envy should pertain to the person’s work, not to the person. Yet in the age of celebrity culture, we tend to equate someone’s accomplishments with his or her persona. This can translate into a misplaced desire to find fault with the person we envy to compensate for our negative feelings. We should be thinking, “Boy, I wish I could paint like that!” Instead we may think, “I wish I were just like so-and so, and if I’m not, he or she probably isn’t very nice anyway!”

Can artist envy ever work in a positive way? Two thoughts come to mind. The first is that if you are wishing you were the one who had won the award or done that beautiful and creative work, this can motivate you to work harder and be more serious in your efforts. The second thought concerns the artist who is the subject of that envy. Perhaps he or she is somewhat shy or lacks confidence. To a great extent, achieving success with our art can boost that confidence and elevate our stature among our peers, enabling us to feel more comfortable among those we consider to be more accomplished. This can even carry over to how we feel about ourselves in a general sense. For better or worse, we sometimes tend to be judged, not by who we are, but by the successes we have had. What do you think?

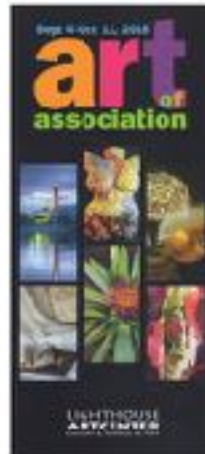
